

City of Hobart visit tour of pedestrian orientated design
Melbourne 17 February 2017

Purpose:

Undertake a tour of pedestrian orientated design in inner Melbourne that includes innovative approaches to pedestrian crossings and treatments that provide for walkers at roundabouts, and cycling treatments where possible.

Key information: the tour will include sites in the Cities of Darebin, Yarra (time permitting), Stonnington and Port Phillip. 9.45	Delegates arrive at 9.45 at 11 Eley Rd, Reservoir to be met by Che Sutherland (who will join the tour)
10.00am	Tour commence 11 Eley Road, Reservoir
10.30	Travel to High St (Via Hutton St pedestrian/cycle refuge)
10.50	Arrive High Street at Ballantyne St (raised thresholds)
11.10	Travel to Amess St, Carlton North (City of Yarra)
11.25	Arrive Amess St (Linear Path priority reversal on Capital City Trail)
11.40	Travel to City of Stonnington
	If time permits, a very quick stop to a 20km Shared Zone under construction Stewart St Richmond that is on route.
12.15	Arrive Prahran Town Hall (Chapel and Greville Streets)
12.30	Welcomed by the Mayor of Stonnington, Mayor Cr Jami Klisaris , over lunch in the Committee Room.
1.00pm	Walk along Greville Street, to the Prahran train station, then back to Grattan Gardens for questions. Examine current design and future plans for Greville St including recent pop-up trial and pedestrian facilities including current 'zebra' crossings on all legs of an intersection.
1.45	Travel to City of Port Phillip
2.00	Arrive at the Esplanade (near Luna Park) to be met by Stefan Mitrik, Coordinator

	Transport Safety Engineering. Examine pedestrian safety and walkability improvements including the removal of a slip lane and the installation of a number of raised pavement zebra crossings in a 40kph area.
2.30	Travel to Bridport Street – Victoria Avenue in Albert Park (with Stefan)
2.45	See three roundabouts with raised pavement zebra crossings, intersection modifications (kerb extensions some with WSUD – water sensitive urban design and staggering) a pair of easy access tram stops (40kph area).
3.30	Travel to South Melbourne Marker area (with Stefan)
3.40	Cecil St (Roundabouts with Zebras and separated on road bike lanes).
4.30	Travel to Southern Cross Station
4.50	Arrive Southern Cross
