RE: 12 SELFS POINT ROAD NEW TOWN

Ten Lives have enjoyed the support of the Hobart City Council for over Ten Years with a peppercorn lease arrangement allowing us to operate a cat centre at 12 Sels Point Road.

Ten Lives deal with two to three thousand unwanted cats and kittens from the greater Hobart area every year. Last financial year we had 382 cats and kittens surrendered into our care from the Hobart City local government area.

Ten Lives is noticing a positive change in attitude as to how the community care responsibly for cats not only for the welfare of cats but also for the benefit of the community and the environment. Last year we rehomed more cats than ever, all microchipped, desexed and vaccinated.

We would not be able to carry out this vital community service without support from Hobart City Council and Ten Lives Board and members greatly appreciate your ongoing support.

Ten Lives is considering the accommodation requirements to meet the needs of the community in cat management for the next decade and beyond. In so doing we have developed some concept plans for the buildings at 12 Sels Point Road which we intend to further discuss with your officers over the coming year to see if such plans would be acceptable to the Hobart City Council.

Initial budget quotes indicate that this investment would be in the order of a million dollars. Ten Lives will fund at least stage one of the proposed project and we would look to our supporter base to assist with future stages.
