

- The mission to "advance knowledge" is achieved through lectures, publications, awards to outstanding scholars and collaborations with like-minded institutions





RST Special and Rare Book Collection

The Council of the RST recommends the removal of the statue of William Crowther from Franklin Square and the provision of a written interpretation, for example, a plaque, on the site where the statue now stands.

- 1. The RST aspires to develop a respectful relationship with Tasmanian Aboriginal people, a process we began with a formal apology in February 2021.
- 2. The ethical, moral and social context in Hobart in the 1860's and 1870's was very different from that of today.
- 3. The RST mission to "advance knowledge" in this instance can be met by the absence of the statue being a stimulus for discussion of William Crowther's actions and their impacts.






