### Why

Lachlan Macquarie was responsible for the death of many Aboriginal people.

### Who

Lachlan Macquarie was the governor of NSW from 1810 – 1821. In 1816 Lachlan Macquarie ordered soldiers to kill or capture any Aboriginal people they encountered during a military operation aimed at creating 'terror'. At least 14 men, women and children were brutally killed. Source: Nov 10 2017 ABC news report Fact check.
