2021-22 Fees and Charges - City Planning - Animal Management

At the Council meeting on 24 May 2021, Council resolved the schedule of fees and charges for the City Planning Division marked as Attachment A to item 8.1 of the Open City Planning Committee agenda of 17 May 2021, be adopted for the 2021-2022 financial year.

The purpose of this memorandum is to correct an omission in the schedule of fees and charges for the Legal and Animal Management contained within Attachment A to item 8.1 of the Open City Planning Committee agenda of 17 May 2021 by approving a new fee for pensioners with non-desexed dogs paid <u>after</u> 31 July 2021 of \$75.

Following the resolution of 24 May 2021, officers have been preparing dog registration renewals for 1 July 2021 - 30 June 2022 and have identified one fee was omitted from the adopted schedule of fees and charges.

By its resolution 24 May 2021, Council adopted the introduction of a new fees which provides a discount for dogs registered prior to 31 July 2021. The schedule of fees and charges marked as Attachment A to item 8.1 of the Open City Planning Committee agenda of 17 May 2021 included the fee for pensioners with non-desexed dogs paid prior to 31 July 2021 of \$60 but it omitted the fee for pensioners with non-desexed dogs paid after 31 July 2021 of \$75 as shown in the below extract:

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There are approximately 52 non-desexed dogs owned by pensioners. The correction will ensure that fee for pensioners with non-desexed dogs is consistent with all other categories of dogs.
